SUPPLEMENTAL

Captain McCLURE, Lawrence, P.D., was interviewed again on 8-5-70, at approximately 2:30 p.m.

He stated that he did not see Lt. FOUST actually pick the carbine bullet up in front of the Gaslite, but was close by and FOUST was in the area that he described when he called his attention to it.

He took it from FOUST, looked at it, did not see any blood on it nor any foreign substance. It was damaged somewhat.

He put it in his pocket at this time, the only thing that could have been in his pocket would have been a few coins. He would have carried it in his pocket approximately two hours until he got home, and it was put in a jewelry box at this time and it was there until he brought it to the Courthouse and it was turned over to the KBI.

He stated he did not rub it off, clean it or wash it in any manner, other than carry it in his pocket.

He carried it to the Courthouse in his pocket and the only thing that would have been in his pocket would have been some change and keys. The keys had a plastic fob on the key chain, a sample of this was obtained. The jewelry box did not have anything in it and no one would have bothered it nor known it was in there but him.

It was decided to not ask him at this time if he would take a polygraph test.
