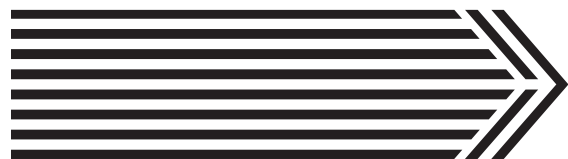

## A REIMAGINED MUSEUM FOR ALL



Our recent changes to the collection galleries are part of ongoing architectural improvements to better serve the needs of our audiences. Renovations completed in 2016 introduced new learning and study centers on our third floor and transformed the galleries with light-filled views into the Museum at our entrance as well as windows overlooking historic Marvin Grove.



The freshly completed fourth-floor renovations added an additional study center to increase the ways we can share our collection. Other features include new white oak floors and energy-efficient lighting. But the most exciting change is the art! 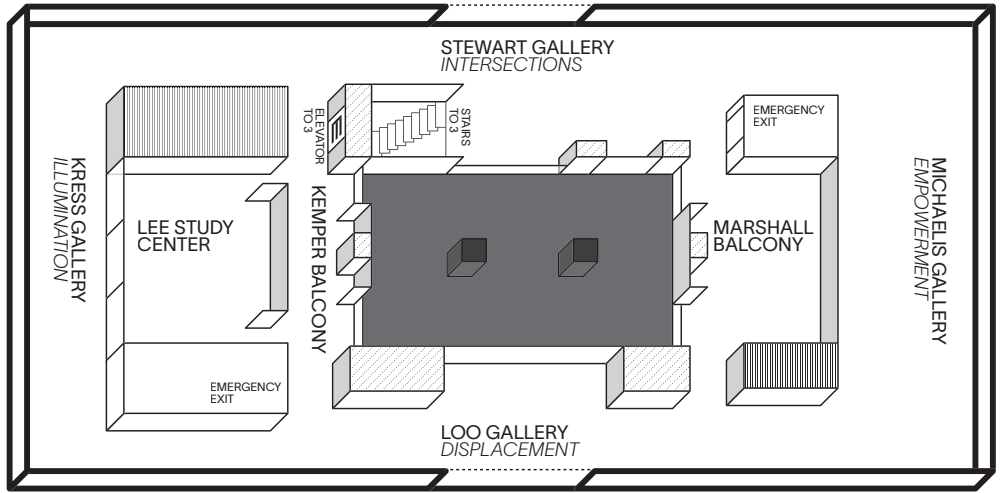

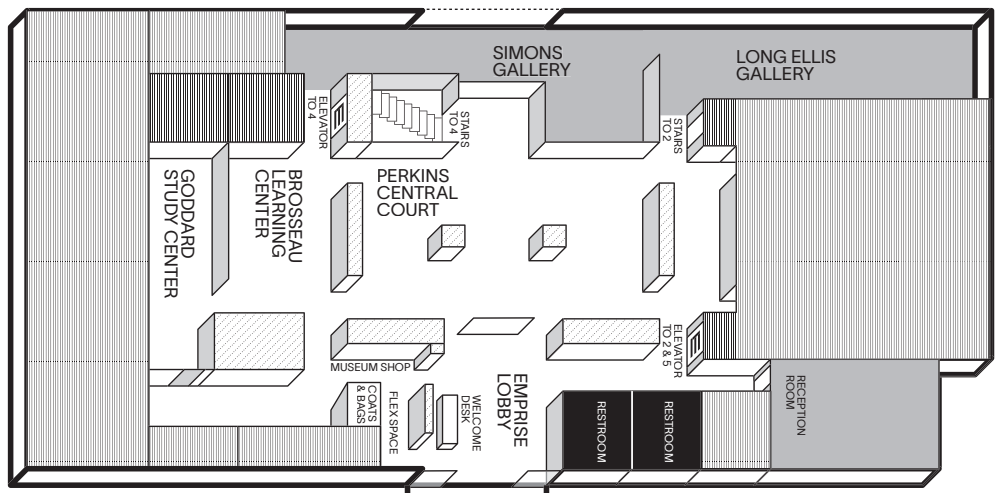

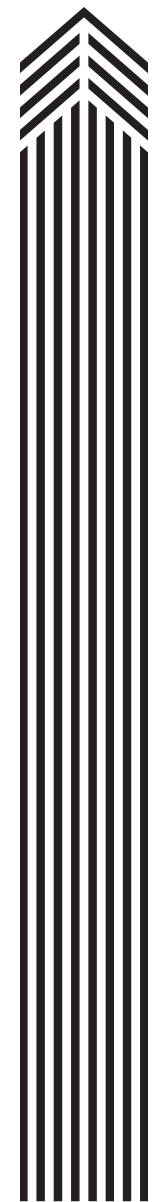
